The Mission of the Baptist Mobile Health Ministry is to help provide caring health service and Christian witness to the underserved persons of Georgia.

Purpose of Baptist Mobile Health Ministry

Baptist Mobile Health Ministry was started as a result of needed health care in communities across the state of Georgia and because of the poverty and indigence of the migrant population. Today, the unit travels to any Georgia Baptist Convention (GBC) church, association or event with GBC involvement where there is a desire to reach out to their community in the name of Christ. We seek to meet the physical and spiritual needs of underserved persons throughout Georgia.

Baptist Mobile Health Ministry, Inc. is staffed by medical and dental professionals and lay volunteers local to the project site and by BMHM Unit Coordinators. Services provided are rendered without charge to those receiving the care.

Medical services include basic screening, diagnosis and treatment of common medical problems by physicians. Dental service includes extraction, restoration and cleaning of teeth provided by dentists and hygienists.
